About this Dashboard

Proposal & Award Metrics Dashboard (PAMDash) provides self-service access to proposal and award data metrics. It was created in response to the growing need for departments to monitor extramural funding metrics. The Office of Sponsored Research (OSR) and the Controller's Office collaborated to develop the dashboard, now managed by Project and Data Team under Contracts and Grants Accounting (CGA).

Data Sources and Update Frequency

Data on submitted proposals are from the Proposal Express module in the PeopleSoft Research Administration System (RAS) and CACTAS. These data are managed by OSR. Data on awards are from the PeopleSoft Research Administration System (RAS). When applicable, data on awarded amounts and funding mechanisms are sourced from the RAS Awards module. These data are managed by the Controller's Office, Contracts & Grants Accounting.

All data are refreshed daily, as indicated by the date/time stamp at the bottom of each dashboard page.

In cases where the value of a common data element differs between Proposal Express and the Award module, the value stored in the Award module has been selected for reporting. See Data Definitions below for additional details.

Reporting Years

Data are aggregated in all metrics by fiscal year, beginning with proposals submitted in 2014. Optional views by calendar year and federal fiscal year are available, which aggregates data beginning with proposals submitted in FY2013-14.

The starting dates differ between calendar year and fiscal year views in order to begin all metrics with a full year of data. The start date for the calendar year view is January 1st and for the fiscal year view is July 1st. For federal fiscal year the start date is October 1st.

General Use Notes

Common Filters. Filters are provided to limit data in all graphs to a specific subset of data. Setting a filter will recalculate all graphs across all tabs of the dashboard.

Page Filters: These filters will update all charts only on this specific page simultaneously.
